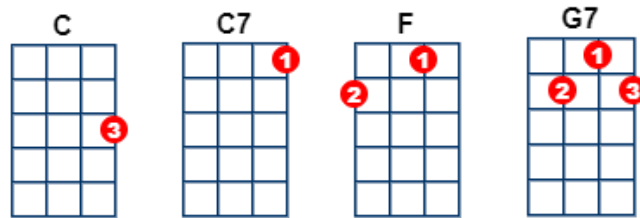


Ballad of John & Yoko – The Beatles
