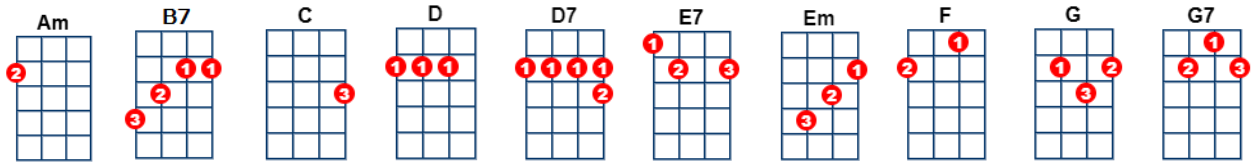


Delilah (The Twirl Girl) – Karine Woodward
