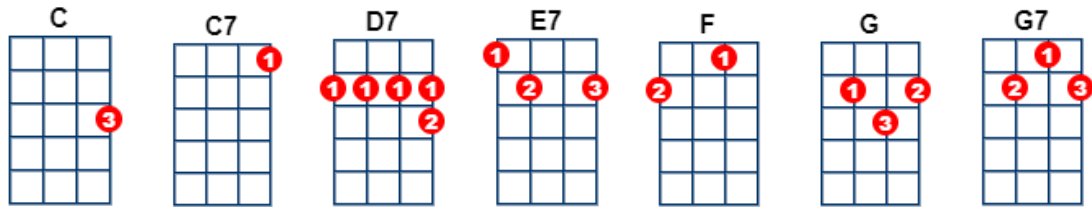


Old Time Medley of Tipperary & Pack Up Your Troubles
