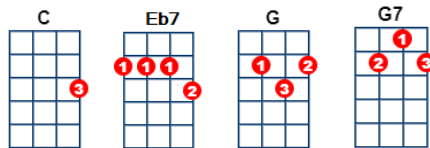


(Baritone) **Ballad of John & Yoko** – The Beatles
