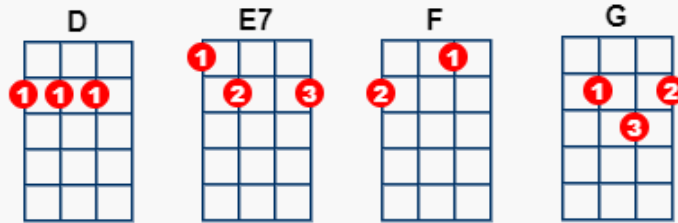


A Certain Girl – The Yardbirds (1965)
