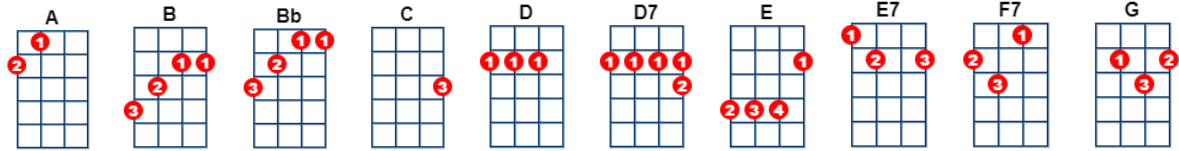


Agadoo – Black Lace (1984)
