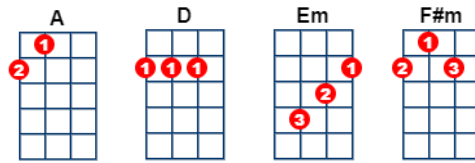


Ain't No Doubt – Jimmy Nail (1992)
