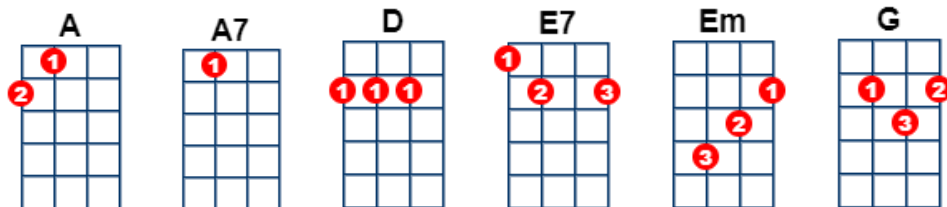


Away in A Manger - (1895)
