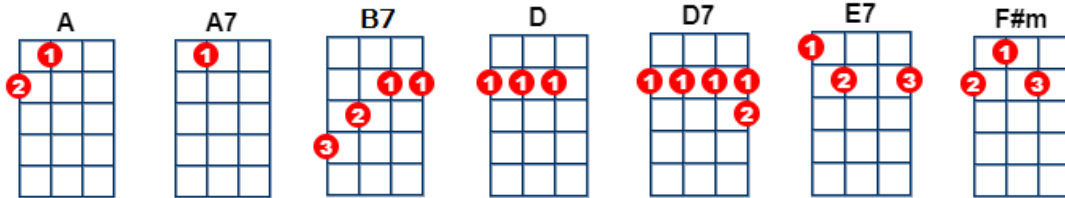


Baby's in Black – The Beatles (1964)
