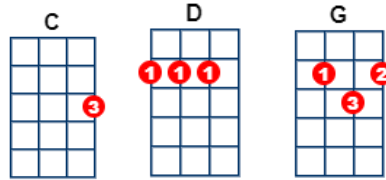


Band of Gold – Freda Pain (1970)
