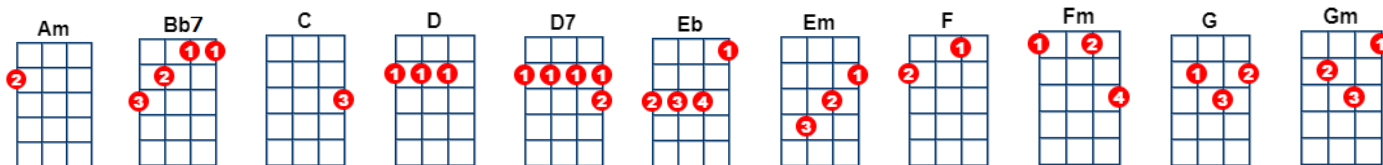


Breaking Up Is Hard To Do – Neil Sedaka (1960)
