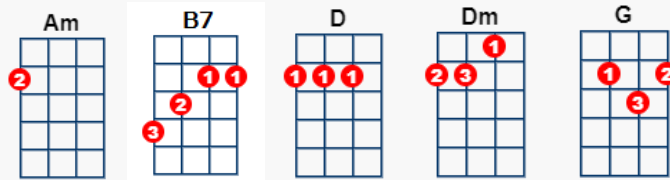


Everybody Wants to be a Cat – Scatman Crothers/Jamie Cullum (2016)
