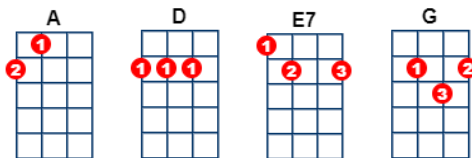


Goodbye Girl – Squeeze
