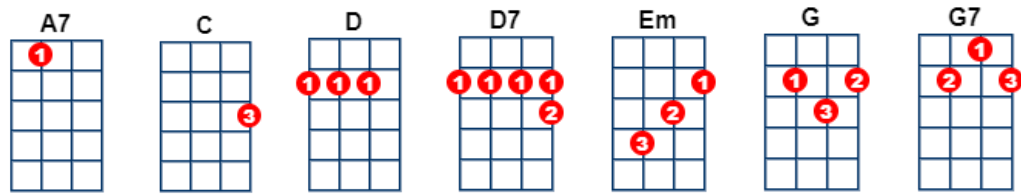


Hallelujah, I Love Her So – Ray Charles
