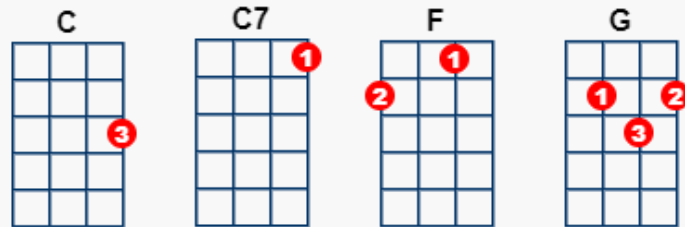


I Want To Walk You Home – Fats Domino (1959)
