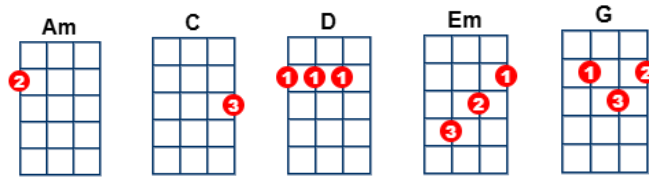


# It's Five O'Clock Somewhere – Alan Jackson
