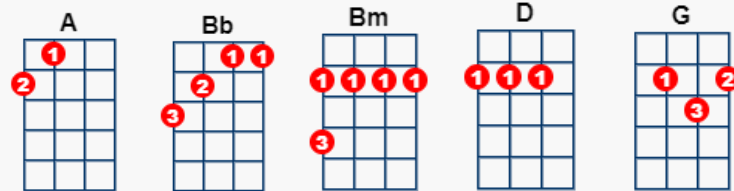


Last Night In Soho – Dave Dee, Dozy, Beaky, Mick and Titch (1968)
