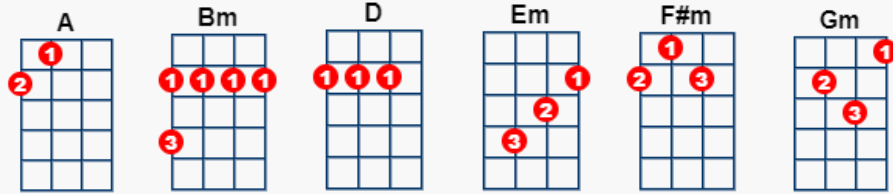


Man of the World – Fleetwood Mac
