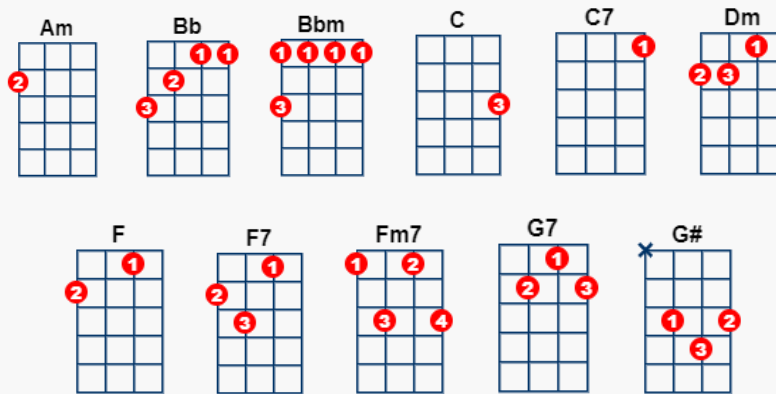


Silly Games – Janet Kay (1979)
