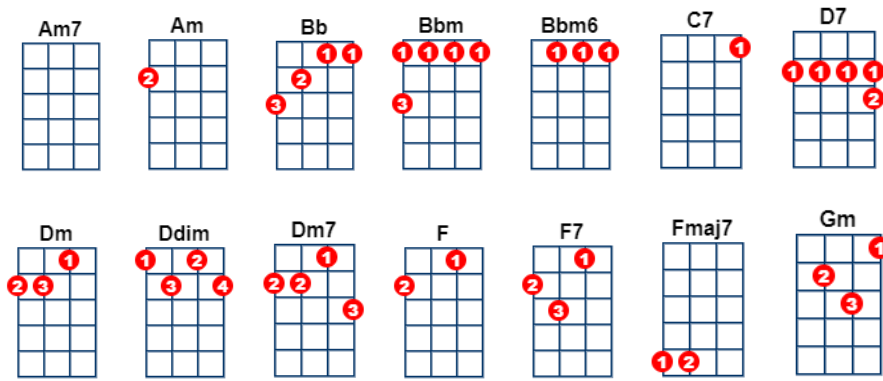


Too Young/Smile – Nat King Cole

 [F] You'll see the [Ddim] sun come shining [Gm] through
 [Am7] For you.

[F] Light up your face with gladness
 [Fmaj7] Hide every trace of sadness
 [Dm7] Although a [Ddim] tear may be [Gm] ever so [D7] near
 That's the [Gm] time you must keep on trying
 [Bbm] Smile what's the use of crying
 [F] You'll find that [Ddim] life is still [Gm] worthwhile
 [Am7] If you'll just [F] smile.
