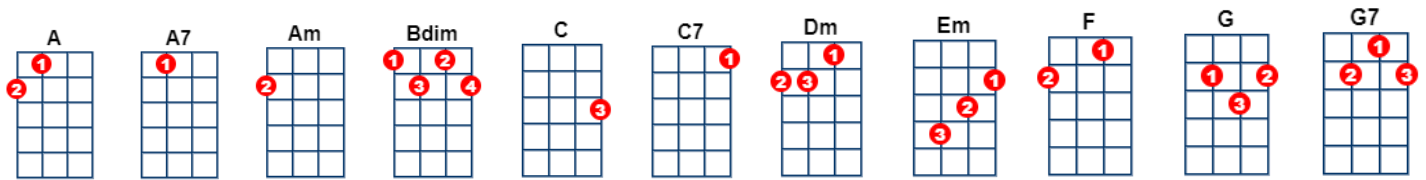


Walk Right Back –Everley Brothers
