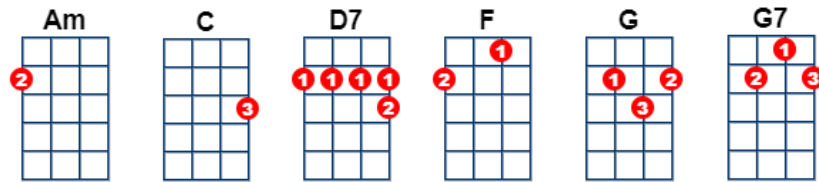


Waterloo – ABBA (1974)
