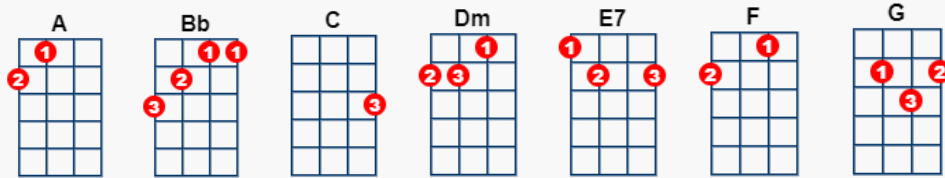


We Used To Know – Jethro Tull
