


Wouldn't It Be Lovely (key of D) – Audrey Hepburn

[G] Far away from the [A7] cold night [D7] air.

[G] With [D7] one e-[Dm]normous [E7] chair,

Oh! [G] Wouldn't [D] it be [Am7] lover-[D7]ly?

[G] Lots of chocolate for [C] me to [Am7] eat, [D7]

[G] Lots of coal makin' [A7] lots of [D7] 'eat.

[G] Warm [D7] face, warm [Dm] hands, warm [E7] feet,

Oh! [G] Wouldn't [D7] it be [G] lovely?

[D]/ Oh, [A7 / so [D] lovely sittin'

[A7] Abso-bloomin'-[D]lute-[F#7]ly [Bm] still. [D7]

[G]/ I [F#7]/ would [Bm] never [E7] budge 'til [A7] spring
